Polo Tops


If you are interested New long and short s sleeve golf polo tops are available for sale. Also wide-brimmed hats and club golf caps are available from Alan Kinnaird

2019 US Open

Gary Woodland won the 2019 U.S. Open golf tournament by three strokes over a golfer who was trying pull off the three-peat.

Brooks Koepka was the two-time defending champion, having won the 2017 and 2018 U.S. Opens. Only one golfer in tournament history — Willie Anderson in 1903-05 — won three consecutive U.S. Opens.

No golfer since Peter Thomson in the British Open in the early 1950s has won any of the majors three times in a row.

No one will bring home more money this year than Gary Woodland, who not only captured his first major championship by dominating Pebble Beach but also hauled in a cool \$2.25 million. Runner-up Brooks Koepka, the event's back-to-back defending champion, claimed \$1.35 million.

Inspired by the story, the doctor said, "You must be one hell of an outdoors man!"




