

Smith triumphs in Hawaii for first individual win

Cameron Smith's long-running battle to win a US PGA Tour tournament as an individual is over.

Smith, the 26-year-old Queenslander who rates as one of the best young players in the world, won a playoff against American Brendan Steele in wet conditions to take out the Sony Open at Waialae Country Club near Honolulu.

The former Australian amateur champion and Presidents Cup star's only previous win on the tour was in a team's event, the 2017 Zurich Classic with Jonas Blixt.

It was the second Australian victory inside 24 hours for Australians, with Adelaide's Wade Ormsby having taken out the Hong Kong Open on the Asian Tour on Sunday. "That's one I've been wanting to tick off for a long time," he said later. "I've been out here for five years now and to finally say I've won an event myself is quite good."

Smith has been trending up for a while now, in the light of his victory over Justin Thomas in singles at the Presidents Cup. He was also runner-up in the World Cup in Melbourne at the end of 2018 with Marc Leishman, representing Australia.
