Temporary Local Rules January 2025 at Trentham

To be read in conjunction with HVGC rules that apply at all courses we play at, available on your MiScore app

PREFERRED LIES

When a player's ball lies in a part of the general area cut to fairway height or less, the player may take free relief **once** by placing their ball within one club length, no nearer the hole.

BUNKERS

Due to unfinished renovations in all bunkers, players may lift, rake, and place their ball as close as possible to where their ball initially lay in the bunker.

With reference to the in-filled bunkers on the right-hand side of the 9th and 10th greens, these are to be treated as GUR and relief must be taken in accordance with Rule 16.1.

GROUND UNDER REPAIR

Unless specifically stated, players **must** take relief from all GUR in the general area, in accordance with Rule 16.1.

Players **may** take relief from the following in accordance with Rule 16.1:

- Leaf, stick and mulch piles
- Burnt ash piles
- Storm damage: Any disturbed areas due to tree removal, ground out stumps, or cut and standing stumps
- If a ball comes to rest on a tree root, or a tree root interferes with a player's stance or swing, relief may be taken in accordance with Rule 16.1b

Post and rope barriers are to be treated as immovable obstructions and relief **must** be taken in accordance with rule 16.1. If your ball

hits the port or rope, it **must be played as it** lies. Players are not allowed to replay the shot.

Little Known Golf Trivia

- 1. Golf was one of the only sports played on the moon. Alan Bartlett Shepard Jr. used a 6-iron to play golf on the moon!
- 2. The first round of women's golf was played in the year 1811 in Musselburgh, Scotland.
- 3. The very first nationally televised golf tournament, the 1953 World Championship of Golf, featured an incredible finish from Lew Worsham.
- 4. The oldest golf tournament in the world is the Open Championship which was founded in 1860.
- 5. It's pretty widely accepted that golf began in Scotland 500+ years ago. The Chinese, however, claims to have invented a similar game during the Song dynasty as far back as 943 A.D.
- 6. The modern game of golf originated in Scotland in the 15th century.
- 7. The first recorded game of golf took place in 1457 on the links at St. Andrews in Scotland.

- 8. The word "golf" comes from the Scottish word "gouf," which means "to strike or hit."
- 9. The first written rules of golf were created in 1744 by the Gentlemen Golfers of Leith, a golf club in Scotland.
- 10. The first golf club, the Blackheath Golf Club, was founded in London, England in 1766.
- 11. The first golf tournament, the Gentlemen Golfers of Leith Competition, was held in 1744 in Scotland.
- 12. The first golf course in the United States was built in 1851 at the St. Andrews Golf Club in New York.
- 13. The first golf club in the United States, the Foxburg Country Club, was founded in 1887 in Pennsylvania.
- 14. The first professional golfer was Allan Robertson, a Scottish golfer who began giving exhibitions and lessons in the 1840s.
