KOORINGAL GOLF CLUB LOCAL RULES To be read in conjunction with the Rules of Golf and any Temporary Local Rules

- OUT OF BOUNDS – Rule 18.2**
- Defined with White Stakes with Black Tops
 - The line between the course-side points at ground level of boundary fences
 - Painted bricks near clubhouse.
 - When playing the 14th hole, the 15th hole is out of bounds as defined by white pegs with black tops. These stakes are treated as boundary objects during play of the 14th hole. For all other holes, they are immovable obstructions.
 - Maintenance Shed & works area is out of bounds as defined by white paint with black tops painted on fence and posts.

ABNORMAL COURSE CONDITIONS – Rule 16.1

GROUND UNDER REPAIR

Relief may be taken

- Deep wheel ruts made by vehicle or course machinery. Relief **must** be taken
- Staked trees and staked shrubs – are NO PLAY ZONES and are ground under repair (the GUR includes the stake and any wrapping)
- From any area encircled by white stakes or a white line

IMMOVABLE OBSTRUCTIONS

- Grates and Tap covers
- All Artificially sealed roads and paths
- Internal Protective fencing

MOVEABLE OBSTRUCTION

- All stakes, hoops, chains and signs are moveable obstructions. Please replace the obstruction in the same spot after playing the shot.

IMMOVABLE OBSTRUCTIONS (E.G. SPRINKLER HEADS) CLOSE TO THE PUTTING GREEN – LINE OF PLAY INTERFERENCE

- Rule 16.1b applies to immovable obstructions close to the putting greens. In addition to the types of inference described in Rule 16.1a, interference also exists if an immovable obstruction is: on the player's line of play, and is within two club-lengths of the ball and/or the obstruction is within two club-lengths of the green (Exception – There is no relief under this Local Rule if the player chooses a line of play that is clearly unreasonable.)

NO FREE RELIEF Garden beds and mulched areas are integral objects unless defined by white stakes or painted lines.

Unless otherwise noted the penalty for a breach of a Local Rule is the general penalty (stroke play – two shots, match play – loss of hole)

STAKE MARKINGS

- Penalty areas – yellow/red stakes
- GUR – White stakes/white lines
- OOB – White stakes with black tops or similar painting on bricks (near clubhouse)

and on fencing for the maintenance shed and works area

DISTANCE MARKERS TO CENTRE OF EACH GREEN

Please refer to notice board in golf shop for any temporary local rules

AVOID SLOW PLAY, REPLACE DIVOTS
REPAIR PLUG MARKS ON THE GREENS
COURSE STAFF HAVE RIGHT OF WAY AT ALL TIMES

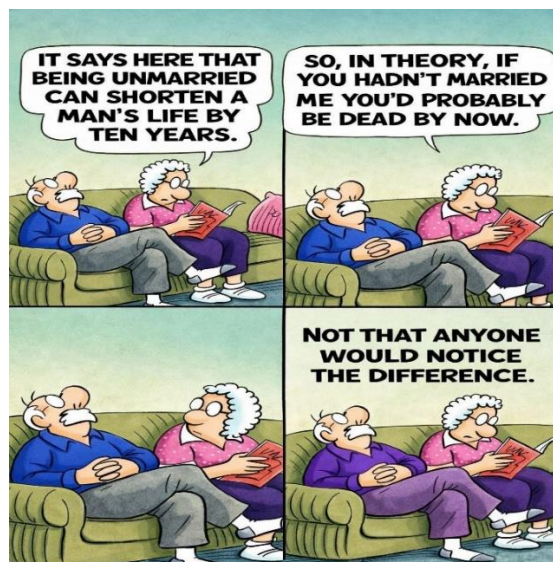

Championship Conditions

1. All entrants (both men and women) must be a financial member of the Victorian Veteran Golfers Association (VVGA) and hold a valid Golf Australia Golfer ID.
Interstate visitors are welcome to enter but will be ineligible to win the 4BBB Championship.
2. All entry fees must be paid at the time of entry.
3. All VVGA tournaments are to be conducted under the control of the Host district, Host Club and the VVGA Match Committee chaired by the VVGA Captain. All queries are to be referred to this Committee which has the authority to deal with and determine suitable action. The relevant Zone

Councillor will be co-opted to the Match Committee for the tournament and is required to liaise with the host district organising committee.

4. A Golf Australia (GA) Handicap limit of 36 for Male & 45 for Female players applies to all Championship events.
5. All competitions shall be played in accordance with the rules of golf as adopted by the Royal and Ancient Rules Limited and the United States Golf Association.
6. The Match Committee of the VVGA shall have the power to deal with and resolve any dispute or protest which must be lodged with the VVGA Captain (or his deputy) within 15 minutes of the conclusion of the day's play. The Match Committee's decision will be final.
7. The Council of the VVGA may, in the event of adverse weather or any other reason, either shorten the event or schedule it for another day.
8. As this is a Stableford event, no playoff is required, winners are to be decided by the standard Golf Australia countback system.
9. Entry fees paid will not be refunded if a scratching is made within two (2) weeks prior to the commencement of the Tournament.
10. Competitors may win only one (1) major trophy for the day.

NOTE: -To promote fellowship amongst players the draw will be arranged, where possible, to have entrants playing with competitors from other Districts.
