GOLF BALLS AVAILABLE

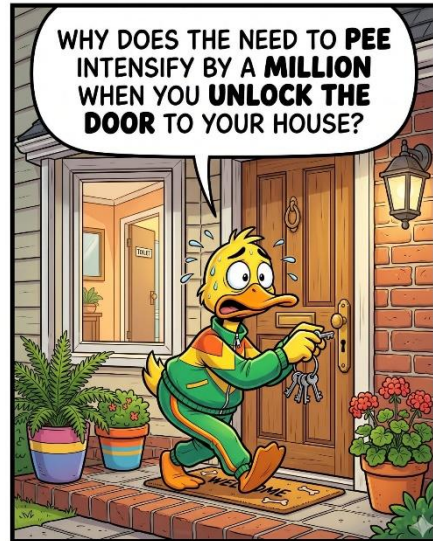


Members are reminded that the club is holding a
