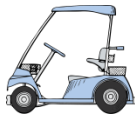

FOR PURE IRONS, KEEP THE BACK FOOT DOWN

If you want to improve accuracy and consistency with your iron shots, take a closer look at the footwork of PGA Tour player Bryson DeChambeau. One thing he does that leads to laser-straight irons is keep his right foot stable during the downswing. The right foot, while staying grounded longer, rolls a little toward the target. This lateral motion allows the right knee to shift slightly in the same direction and helps the hips tilt and slide properly. The correct lower-body sequence creates consistent contact, a more stable clubface at impact and optimal trajectory on iron shots.
